DAY 1

This trip to Bowling Green will get you revved up and ready for fun! Jump start your day with a tour of the **General Motors Bowling Green Assembly Plant** – the only place in the world America’s Sports Car is manufactured. The 1-hour, 1-mile walking tour will take you through the process of producing a Corvette. *Remember – no cell phones, cameras, purses, back packs, open-toe shoes and check their website for tours.*

Journey just across the street to the **National Corvette Museum**, a 115,000 sq. ft. ‘gateway to all things Corvette.’ The Museum includes many new interactive and hands-on exhibits, a film about Corvette history in the Chevrolet Theater, period exhibits, a huge Corvette Store and more! While your there, be sure and make a pit stop in the **Corvette Café**, a 50s-themed diner, and choose from burgers, shakes and even modern-day favorites like wraps, soups and daily specials.

After lunch, venture across the street to **Vette City Antiques** and Flea Market for shopping.

Next travel to **Lost River Cave** and explore what Ripley’s Believe It or Not claims is the shortest, deepest river in the world! Enjoy their sluice mine, butterfly habitat, bird watching and hiking trails. Even if caves aren’t your thing, there’s plenty of nature to enjoy in the Valley!

Take a break for some needed rest and relaxation at the hotel before heading back downtown to Bowling Green’s oldest brick home for a delicious local meal at **Mariah’s Restaurant**. Choose from steak, seafood, pasta, salad and other favorites.

DAY 2

After sleeping in, catch some breakfast at the hotel then travel just over 30 minutes north to **Dinosaur World** in Cave City where the outdoor museum is not just about prehistoric animals but also about having fun and learning! Un-earth a dinosaur in the bone yard, and mine for fossils at the fossil dig. Discover a T-Rex, Stegosaurus and Triceratops as well as new dinosaurs discovered in recent decades.

Grab a buffet lunch across the street at the **Watermill Restaurant**. This mom and pop shop offers a delicious hot buffet that will suit any taste buds!

Kentucky Down Under in Horse Cave! Learn first-hand about kangaroos, emus, wallabies and other exotic creatures from the Land Down Under. Enjoy bright colored lorikeets as they light on your hands or shoulders, become involved in life on a typical Australian sheep station, and explore exotic Kentucky Caverns.
