Vendor Setup/Tear Down:

Vendor Setup will begin at 8am the day of the event. Tear down can occur after 3pm.

Cancellation/Refunds:

We request that you notify us promptly if you cancel your planned attendance so that we can adjust our layout and offer the space to our other vendors. Please contact the Vendor Coordinator at the National Corvette Museum at 270-467-8846 and notify her of your decision.

Restricted Merchandise:

Vendors shall not sell any merchandise that conflicts, or is in competition to the National Corvette Museum Corvette Store. Any items that are the same or similar we will request to the vendor that these items be removed immediately. Also, the sale of guns, knives, martial arts weapons, fireworks, ammunition, adult items and drug paraphernalia is explicitly prohibited. All items bearing the name Corvette, logos, outline, etc. that are sold must be approved by GM and bear the GM Approval sticker.

Food vendors are not permitted. Packaged foods (jams, jellies, honey, bread, candy, etc) are allowed.

Kentucky State Sales Tax:

The State of Kentucky requires that any vendor selling merchandise must collect and remit 6% Kentucky sales tax. Contact Debra Jordan at the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet at 270-746-7470 for further information.

Damage, Loss by Fire, Theft or Other Causes:

The National Corvette Museum assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss by fire, theft or any other causes whatsoever. Vendors and spectators use the facilities at their own risk and agree to indemnify and save harmless the National Corvette Museum, its agents and employees from any loss or liability including but not limited to costs of defense, arising from participation at events conducted by the National Corvette Museum and/or held at the National Corvette Museum. Vendors will indemnify and save harmless the National Corvette Museum for any such loss or liability arising from conduct of any vendor toward another vendor or the public.
