The **NCM Motorsports Park** is an educational and recreational facility featuring a three mile road course plus paddock for autocross and skid pad training exercises. It also has a large, open air pavilion, flanked by day garages with track viewing decks.


For group visits the track offers Corvette rides (hot laps), golf cart autocross (blind and/or impaired exercises), vehicle dynamics training, mirrorkhana, super car driving experiences, group dining or just spectating! ### Mammoth Cave National Park

### Riverview at Hobson Grove

An elegant interpretation of a prosperous Victorian home of the 1860-1890 period.

### Kentucky Museum

Housed in the historic Kentucky Building on Western Kentucky University's campus with exhibits including 'Instruments of American Excellence,' 'Recommended by Duncan Hines' and a world-renowned quilt gallery.

### Aviation Heritage Park

Outdoor display with aircraft including an F-4D Phantom II, and F9F-5 Panther, F-111F Aardvark and a T33 Shooting Star.

### Corsair Artisan Distillery

Independent craft distillery handcrafting small batches of spirits and whiskey using

classic pot stills. Tours and tastings are available with reservations.

### South Union Shaker Village

Experience the tranquil communal village of the hard-working Shaker religious group, designers of some of America's finest architecture, highly regarded furniture and creators of a haven for tolerance and simplicity.

### Downing Museum at Baker Arboretum

View works by painter and sculptor Joe Downing. The collection includes examples of his abstraction and experimentation with different media including leather, linen, canvas, old wood, metal and found objects.

### Chaney's Dairy Farm

Farm tours, jumping pillow, playground, homemade ice cream, homemade food and more. Summer Ice Cream & a Moovie and Fall Corn Maze and Pumpkin Patch.

### Jackson's Orchard and Nursery

Fruits, honey, pumpkins, greenhouse, and freshly made apple cider. Kid-friendly play area. Seasonal festivals: Peach, Apple or Pumpkin with hayrides to pick your own, petting farm, inflatables, concessions.
