



GUIDELINES FOR DISPLAYING YOUR CAR AT THE NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM

The following are the guidelines in order to have your Corvette considered for display at the National Corvette Museum:

- a. We would like the car to be available for a 9 to 12 month period.
- b. You are responsible for transportation to and from the Museum.
- c. When the car is placed on display you are responsible for any additives for the gasoline.
- d. The Museum has battery tenders that can be placed on the car periodically if you wish.
- e. The Museum requires that you maintain your own fire, theft and damage policy.
Please include a copy of "proof of insurance" with your application to display your car.
- f. We do require that you be a member of the Museum to display your car.

Please submit the completed forms along a couple of current photos of your Corvette. Once the completed forms and pictures are received a file will be set up and when an opening comes up for your model year, it will be presented to the Display Committee for consideration.
