IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The undersigned acknowledge the following terms and conditions concerning the Museum delivery process:

- Due to the dynamics of the production process, Chevrolet cannot guarantee actual production and delivery dates in advance. Therefore, the customer should not commit to any non-cancelable reservations or other arrangements. Chevrolet will not compensate anyone for lost time, missed arrangements or expenses incurred due to delays in production and delivery date.
- The customer must bring license plate(s) or proper temporary tags, a valid operator license, proof of ownership (registration, title, bill of sale, etc.), as well as proof of insurance to the National Corvette Museum in order to take possession of his/her vehicle.
- The customer and selling dealer will be notified by the National Corvette Museum of a two-week period during which delivery should take place at the Museum. If arrangements are not made for vehicle pick-up within that time period, and after a good faith effort to reschedule within seven days, the Corvette must be shipped at selling dealer's expense to the selling dealer's location.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SELLING DEALER

- All applicable Courtesy Delivery and Museum fees will be charged to option R8C on the vehicle invoice and ultimately credited to the National Corvette Museum.
- The normal process of automatic fuel credit payment will not occur on a Corvette with the R8C Museum Delivery option. The National Corvette Museum will be paid the appropriate fuel credit.
- Once produced, the Corvette will be invoiced to the selling dealer listed above. The selling dealer is therefore responsible to pay for the unit prior to drop the shipment to the National Corvette Museum or arrange to floorplan the unit until paid for by the customer.
- Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) is performed by, and paid to the National Corvette Museum.
- Selling dealer designates the National Corvette Museum as selling dealer's agent for the limited purpose of delivery of the Corvette to customer.
