DESCRIPTION

The Museum Education Intern assists with all aspects of the education team's role within the National Corvette Museum (NCM). This position performs various tasks related to educational programming for school groups and community events and preparation of educational materials for these audiences.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with the development of various curriculums for all grade levels (a focus on 4th through 12th grade).
- Assist with conducting and facilitating student tours and visits.
- Attend community events to promote educational offerings at the NCM.
- Work on special departmental projects when needed.
- Perform research for educational program development and present findings to Education Manager.
- Perform various administrative tasks including responding to phone calls and inquiries regarding NCM'S education division.
