We have 161 Corvettes registered for the Southwest Caravan and, at this pace, we're on track to hit 200 - 250 Corvettes by the time Aug. 22, 2024 comes around and we meet in Pasadena. If you have Corvette friends or club members that have not signed up for this incredible experience you encourage them to sign up now!

I hope all registered Southwest Caravanners have taken advantage of the hotel room blocks at each overnight stop. If you registered, CFO Paula Megowan emailed you a confirmation and a spread-

sheet of all the hotels for each of your seven stops including Bowling Green (BG). Be sure to check with BG hotels because many of them have 3- or 4-night minimums.

I still have 25 rooms left at the TRU by Hilton in Bowling Green. They all have King beds and run \$219 per night. If you want one email me directly and I will put your name on a list that will be submitted to the hotel this spring when they will finalize your booking.

I have one other hotel in BG that is doing the same thing and it is the Embassy Suites, which is the nicest and newest hotel in Bowling Green. I have only one King Suite room and four double Queen Suite rooms left. They run \$375 per night. Email me ASAP if you want one of these rooms.

Your Southwest Caravan Organizing Team is here for you. We want all our Caravanners to have a wonderful experience during our trip to BG this August. This Team of 10 has 2 1/2 years of planning under our belts. We are doing our best to ensure you have the trip of a lifetime!

You'll get to experience the 30th Anniversary of the National Corvette Museum's 1994 opening. Caravanners who are also registered for the 30th Anniversary Celebration will enjoy three days of activities in and around the Museum, special presentations, raffles, and more! NCM will utilize shuttle buses to transport participants around the campus and parking lots.

Parking will be available at the Museum and the NCM Motorsports Park. Handicap parking spaces will be located in all lots and available on a first come first served basis. Handicap parking at the Motorsports Park and in the Museum's grass areas will be immediately adjacent to shuttle pickup and drop-off.

PreRun 7

In the weeks before the posting of this issue of the eNews the Organizing Team needed to meet with the sales staff at the M Resort concerning the parking lot we will use for Caravan staging on the morning of 23AUG2024. Additionally, Day Two of the trip will include an event we are having at the School of Performance Driving at Spring Mountain Motorsports Ranch along with a longer drive after we were forced to move the Day Two overnight from Cedar City UT to Bryce Canyon City UT.

Because of the tight schedule, we want all Caravanners to stop for gas on Thursday afternoon before proceeding to the M Resort. There will be no time to do that Friday morning. To that end, the Team sent XO Halverson to Henderson to tie up loose ends in a meeting with the M sales staff and to locate fuel stops that are easy in/easy out and have the capacity to fuel a lot of cars at one time.

We found the perfect gas stop just off I-15 in quirky, Jean NV, about a dozen miles southwest of the M. The town's official population is 0 because it's all zoned commercial, has no residents and, right now, its only casino is vacant. "Terrible's Road House Chevron" is 55,000 sqft. and 96 gas pumps–it could fuel almost half the entire Southwest Caravan at one time. It's the World's largest Chevron and will be the strongly recommended final fuel stop on Day One of the Caravan.

Finally, PreRun 7 explored an alternate route from a recommended fuel stop to the M in Henderson.

Southwest Caravan Registration Information

In eNews7 we asked Southwest Corvette Caravaners to register early. So far, many Caravaners have done just that. Southwest Section CFO, Commander Paula Megowan, told the eNews just before deadline, that 161 cars are registered for the Southwest Section of the National Caravan.

As announced in **e**News6, the Southwest Caravan costs \$100. Going to fee-based registration was a difficult decision for the Caravan Organizing Team because the previous SW Caravans did not charge a fee. Both the 2014 and 2019 Southwest Caravans lost money. Since the National Corvette Museum does not backstop any of a Caravan Section's finances, Captains take all the financial risk. The Section Captains for 2014 and 2019 both paid significant financial shortfalls after the two events concluded.

One of Captain Bill Herold's first policy decisions for the 2024 Caravan was the Section was going to charge per car. At an Organizing Team Meeting in mid-January 2023, the fee was set at \$100.00.

Registration is accomplished the "old-fashioned" way. SW Caravaners will complete a Registration Form and mail that and a check for \$100 to Commander Paula Megowan, the Section's CFO.

At the end of this issue of eNews is a fillable .pdf into which you can enter data using your computer, tablet, or smartphone. You will print the last page of this eNews then mail the finished form with your check to Paula Megowan who will email you back a confirmation.

The Return of the Blankee Benefit

Starting with the 2014 Caravan, the Southwest Caravan Organizing Team has commissioned commemorative "stadium blankets" displaying the Southwest Corvette Caravan logo. For the 2014 and 2019 Caravans, if a Southwest Caravaner donated, that person received a Stadium Blanket.

At an Organizing Team meeting on 28 June, Section Captain Bill Herold showed a prototype of a '24 stadium blanket and directed the Team to reestablish the popular "Blankee Benefit" program. Our Stadium Blankets will be 50 by 60 inches. They are furlined with the logo and text applied by dye sublimation. They have no border with graphics and text being "full bleed". The Organizing Team is rolling the "Blankee Benefit" into the existing "Caravan Patron Program." A Caravaner's "ticket" into the Blankee Benefit is the minimum \$100.00 donation discussed above. Any Southwest Caravaner who donates \$100 or more becomes a "Caravan Patron" and gets a Southwest Corvette Caravan Stadium Blanket.
